



Fremont Fair Fast Facts

Overview: Since 1972, the Fremont Fair has established itself as Seattle's largest and most beloved street festival. Produced by the Fremont Chamber of Commerce, the Fremont Fair is a community celebration that captures quirky character of Seattle's eclectic and artistic Fremont neighborhood and takes place annually to mark the start of the Summer Solstice. Coinciding with the Fremont Arts Council's annual Solstice Parade, the Fremont Fair includes performances by local bands, arts & crafts booths, food and drink, and fun for young and old - all coming together to celebrate Fremont's delibertas quirkas culture.

Dates: Saturday and Sunday, June 19-20, 2010

Hours: 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. – Saturday
11 a.m. to 6 p.m. – Sunday
**The Solstice Parade starts Saturday at noon*

Years: The Fremont Fair started in 1972 and celebrates its 39th year in 2010

Cost: Free!

Donations made at the Fair's information booths and beer gardens benefit a number of area non-profits. A portion of the funding is reserved for Solid Ground, a local poverty-focused non-profit who produced the Fair for nearly 40 years. The remaining funds go into the Fremont Chamber of Commerce's grants program and are awarded to non-profits to fund projects that benefit the Fremont community.

Location: Seattle's Fremont neighborhood – main activities occur west of Fremont Ave North on N 35th Street and North 34th Street/Canal Street.

Attendance: The Fremont Fair attracts more than 100,000+ attendees each year

Activities: See exciting features at this year's Fair including:

- **Shopping:** More than 300 shopping booths featuring handmade crafts, colorful world imports and novel creations.
- **Fremont Solstice Parade:** Starting at noon on Saturday, June 19, the Fremont Arts Council presents the 22nd Annual Solstice Parade!
- **Cabiri Performance Troupe on Daedalus:** Sunday, June 20th, don't miss performances on this fully freestanding aluminum aerial dance stage
- **Seattle Art Car Blowout:** See more than 75 funky decorated art cars on display!
- **Live Music:** With two mainstages, both Saturday and Sunday will be filled with unique live music varying from jazz to rock, groove to electro-funk!
